He requested them that all the decisions of the Senate must be honored by the Senators and the Institute.

A. Confirmation of Minutes of 18th Meeting of the Senate held on 8th November, 2008.

The Senate resolved to confirm the minutes of the 18th Senate meeting.

B. Review of Action taken on Minutes of 18th Meeting of the Senate held on 8th November, 2008 at NITK, Surathkal.

The actions taken on the minutes of 18th Senate meeting were reviewed. However, in respect of some of the Agenda Items the resolutions were modified as given below:

Item No. 18-Senate-D3:

Mid-term admission for Research Programme – January 2009.

The Senate approved the proposal for Mid-term admission for M.Tech (Research) and Ph.D for the even semester of 2008-09. It was further resolved to have a uniform fee payment procedure for B.Tech, M.Tech and Ph.D.

Item No. 18-Senate-D17:

Eligibility for admission to MBA programme.

The Senate further resolved that, the course contents and title of the M.Tech programme in Rock Mechanics and Ground Control be reviewed and the recommendations be placed in the next BOS and Senate for consideration.

Item No. 19-Senate-C3:

Rationalisation of PG seats.

The proposal for the rationalization of seats in various post-graduate programmes to meet the requirements of CEI Act was discussed in detail. The revised rationalized seat matrix is given in Annexure – I. It was further resolved that all PG programmes should have a minimum strength of $1/3^{\rm rd}$ of the approved intake capacity to offer the programme in a given year.
